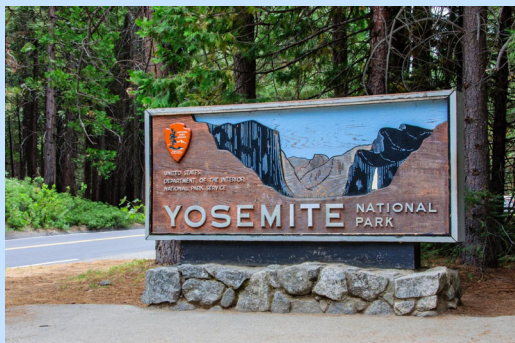

PASTOR'S CORNER: February 25, 2024, *By Vincent Corcoran*

Lent. It is a season of special significance since we attempt to change our lives. Our Lenten experience is a forward journey that leads to Easter joy.

The Lenten environment at St. Dominic's Church becomes a visual experience that expresses the passionate interior voyage we experience. Red violet banners and sanctuary accessories symbolize that passion. Our Lenten environment is a conscious effort to use art as a language for the soul. Icon images are displayed in the choir area so we can reflect more profoundly on a Lenten theme in each of the five Gospels of Lent. We have created a sacred space for worship.

The large vases with dried branches in the sanctuary remind us that we must die to ourselves so we might live in the light of Christ. Repentance and change require humility. St. Paul tells us in 2 Corinthians that that we are earthen vessels that hold a treasure. The pottery represents us, the faithful who are followers of Jesus, as we experience this penitential season. Flowing violet fabric symbolizes the abundant grace that surrounds us during this time of renewal. A large rock represents the virtue of fortitude, the cornerstone for any meaningful change. This art installation invites everyone to prayer and meditation.



The definition of reflect is to receive something back from what we see or experience. Now is the time to see anew during this Lenten season. Through our liturgical environment may we come to know ourselves as children of a loving God.

El ambiente cuaresmal en la Iglesia de Santo Domingo se convierte en una experiencia visual que expresa el apasionante viaje interior que experimentamos. Las banderas rojas y violetas y los accesorios del santuario simbolizan esa pasión. Nuestro ambiente de Cuaresma es un esfuerzo consciente por usar el arte como un lenguaje para el alma. Las imágenes de los iconos se muestran en el área del coro para que podamos reflexionar más profundamente sobre un tema de Cuaresma en cada uno de los cinco Evangelios de Cuaresma. Hemos creado un espacio sagrado para la adoración.

Los grandes jarrones con ramas secas en el santuario nos recuerdan que debemos morir a nosotros mismos para poder vivir a la luz de Cristo. El arrepentimiento y el cambio requieren humildad. San Pablo nos dice en 2 Corintios que somos vasijas de barro que guardan un tesoro. La cerámica nos representa a nosotros, los fieles que somos seguidores de Jesús, mientras vivimos este tiempo penitencial. La tela violeta que fluye simboliza la abundante gracia que nos rodea durante este tiempo de renovación. Una gran roca representa la virtud de la fortaleza, la piedra angular de cualquier cambio significativo. Esta instalación artística invita a todos a la oración y la meditación.
