Returning to the Church After a Long Absence? Here's What to Do

If you're just returning to the Church after being away for a while you may feel nervous about how to return. Maybe you wonder whether you have what it takes to live a truly Catholic life. Be at peace. You're not alone! Many former Catholics are returning to the faith after having left for many reasons.

To help you ease your way back into the Church, here are some suggestions. Talk to another Catholic who is active in his or her faith, and perhaps ask to attend Mass with your Catholic friend. Meet with one of the priests here at St. Dominic's and we will answer any questions you may have and offer assistance to ease your return to the Church. When you feel ready, ask one of us Dominican priests to hear your confession, first in the office so that you have time and won't feel rushed. It might feel intimidating, but we will gently lead you through your confession.

Be patient with yourself and trust in God. Above all, don't be discouraged by how much you have to do to get back into the rhythm of Catholic life. It's a step-by-step process. Just start moving forward. Persevere. The Risen Jesus will fill you with joy and love. Happy Easter!

Sé paciente contigo mismo y confía en Dios. Sobre todo, no te desanimes por lo mucho que tienes que hacer para volver al ritmo de la vida católica. Es un proceso paso a paso. Sólo tienes que empezar a avanzar. Persevera. Jesús resucitado te llenará de alegría y amor. ¡Felices Pascuas!
