

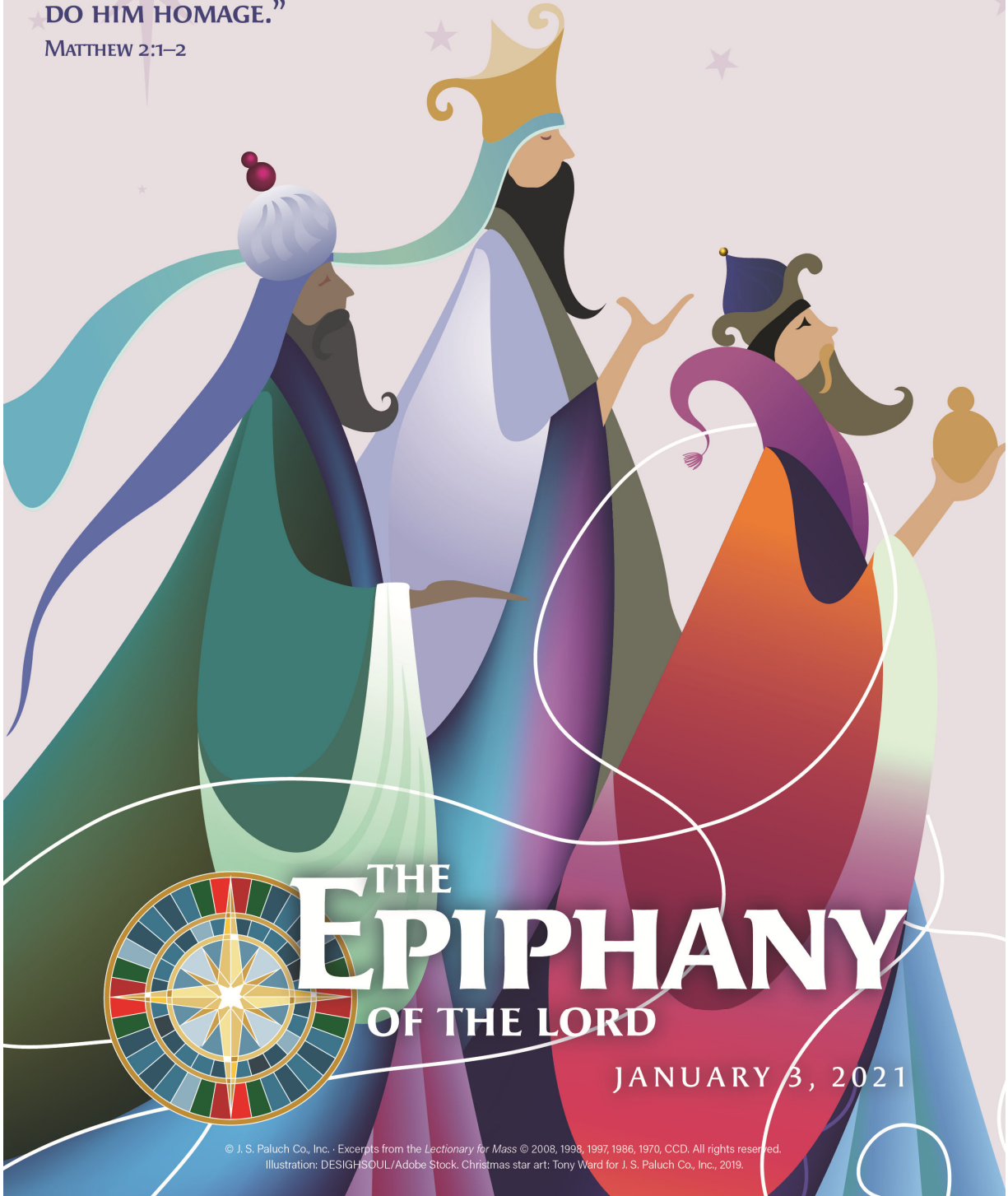

How the ADLA can help victim-survivors heal

When the Vatican released the McCarrick Report late last year, many victim-survivors of sexual abuse may have been triggered by the revelations in the report and the repeated mention of it in the news and on social media. In the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, the Office of Victims Assistance Ministry was created to provide a safe and compassionate environment for victim-survivors who need to report abuse to be able to do so, and to receive assistance for healing. New Year's Resolutions

The New Year is often seen as a time of new opportunities, a chance to start over. Below is a list of some things you might consider doing to grow in your faith and to be a healthier, happier and more peaceful person.

1. Do something to grow in your faith, e.g., join a Bible study, faith-sharing group or ministry here in the parish. There are several groups and meeting times available. Contact the parish office for more information (Phone: 323.254.2519; Email: info@saintdominics.org); read a good Catholic book or article, check out a Catholic website or watch a Catholic YouTube video.
2. Consider giving 1% of your income to the church collection and 1% of your time to serve in a ministry here at Holy Rosary. There are 168 hours in a week. 1% of 168 hours is 1.68 hours, so give at least an hour of your time to serve each week.
3. Take the stairs instead of elevators and escalators to get exercise.
4. Walk or ride your bike more often instead of driving.
5. Schedule "me" time to turn off your cell phone, computer and other electronic devices.
6. Refrain from gossiping and listening to gossip. You'll be a more trustworthy person and will engage in more productive conversations.
7. Do more of what you enjoy doing.
8. If you hate your job, quit your job. Repeat after me: THE MONEY IS NOT WORTH IT. Food and shelter are essential though, so make sure you have another job lined up.
9. Rid yourself of enemies. Apologize for what you did wrong and forgive those who have wronged you.
10. Do not post anything on social media or in a text or email that is negative or that attacks other people, groups or institutions. Our world is filled with too much negativity, and negative posts invite more negativity from others. Be positive, informative and helpful!
11. Stop caring about how many people "like" your social media posts. If you like your post, what else matters? Social media anxiety is a waste of time.
12. Help strangers. "Pay it forward," do good things for others whether you get acknowledged for it or not.
13. Turn off your smartphone, tablet and television at dinner and engage your family or loved ones in conversation.
14. Don't check your social media feeds when you're with friends or family. Pay attention to the people who are with you.

1. Haz algo para crecer en tu fe, por ejemplo, únete a un estudio bíblico, grupo de fe compartida o ministerio aquí en la parroquia. Hay varios grupos y horarios de reuniones disponibles. Comunícate con la oficina parroquial para obtener más información (Teléfono: 323.254.2519; Correo electrónico: info@saintdominics.org). Lee un buen libro o artículo católico, visita un sitio web católico o ve un video católico de YouTube.
2. Considera dar 1% de tus ingresos a la colecta de la iglesia en los domingos y dar el 1% de tu tiempo a servir en un ministerio aquí en Santo Rosario. Hay 168 horas en una semana. 1% de 168 horas es 1.68 horas; así que, puedes dar al menos una hora de tu tiempo para servir cada semana.
3. Usa las escaleras en lugar de los ascensores y escaleras mecánicas para hacer ejercicio.
4. Camina o anda en bicicleta más a menudo en lugar de conducir.
5. Programa tiempo tranquilo para ti y apaga tu teléfono celular, computadora, y otros dispositivos electrónicos.
6. Abstente de contar chismes y de escucharlos. Serás una persona más confiable y participará en conversaciones más productivas.
7. Haz más de lo que te gusta hacer.
8. Líbrate de enemigos. Pide disculpas por lo que hiciste mal y perdona a los que te han hecho mal.
9. No publiques nada en las redes sociales o en un mensaje de texto o correo electrónico que sea negativo o que ataque a otras personas, grupos o instituciones. Nuestro mundo está lleno de demasiada negatividad y las publicaciones negativas invitan a más negatividad de los demás. ¡Sé positivo, informativo y útil!
10. Deja de preocuparte por la cantidad de personas que te den un "me gustó" de tus publicaciones en las redes sociales. Si te gusta tu publicación, ¿qué más importa? La ansiedad por las redes sociales es una pérdida de tiempo.
11. Ayuda a extraños. "Págalo por adelantado" por hacer cosas buenas para los demás – ya sea que te reconozcan o no.
12. Apaga el celular, la tableta y la televisión durante la cena, y participa en la conversación con tus seres queridos.
