

FAREWELL MASS FOR BISHOP SOLIS ON FEBRUARY 1, 2017, AT 7 P.M., ON THE EVE OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

All are invited to attend a farewell Mass for Bishop Oscar Solis at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels on Wednesday, February 1, 2017 at 7 p.m. on the Eve of the Presentation of the Lord. Those planning to attend are also invited to bring a candle to be blessed in commemoration of the feast day.

Bishop Solis was recently appointed as Bishop of the Diocese of Salt Lake City, Utah, by Pope Francis. He will be installed on Tuesday, March 7. Bishop Solis was appointed as Auxiliary Bishop of Los Angeles on December 11, 2003 by Pope John Paul II and ordained on February 10, 2004, becoming the first Filipino-American elevated to the episcopacy in the history of the United States. He will now be the first Filipino-American Bishop to lead a Diocese in the United States.
