

## A Message from Fr. Roberto

### What Does Jesus' Resurrection Mean to You?

We are three weeks into the seven-week Easter season, and, perhaps, you might be asking why the Church spends so much time on Easter. The answer is stated in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* which calls the resurrection of Jesus the “crowning truth of our faith in Christ (#638)” and calls Easter the “Feast of feasts (#1169).” Why? Because Jesus’ resurrection is the foundation upon which our Catholic Church and our Christian faith were built. In spite of all his amazing miracles, incredible compassion and impressive teachings, if Jesus had not risen from the dead there would be no Christianity and no Christians. Jesus would simply have been yet another Jewish prophet who was killed for his challenging message.

Jesus’ resurrection confirms his declaration that he was not just a prophet but the long-awaited Messiah and the Son of God. Because Jesus died and rose again, our sins are forgiven and we have received the gift of eternal life. If Jesus had not risen from the dead, at the very best we would be like religious Jews still awaiting the Messiah.

Yet another important result of Jesus’ resurrection is that it proves to us that love is stronger than hatred, that good conquers evil, that grace overcomes sin and that life wins out over death, not just at the end of our lives, but even now. That means that Jesus’ resurrection is not simply a historic event that took place 2,000 years ago for which we gather every year and shout “Hooray for Jesus!” It is the foundation of hope in our lives. The reality is that Easter is not just about Jesus; rather, it is about all of us human beings and, in fact, all of creation because Jesus’ resurrection is our guarantee that God will turn all our human crucifixions into resurrection, and all death throughout creation into new life. So, no matter what awful thing happens in our lives today or tomorrow, God will get us through, including the war in the Ukraine or war and conflict anywhere for that matter, the ongoing pandemic and all its effects, any natural disaster that is to come or any personal problem we may have to endure in our lives. And the reason we know that God will get us through is because God raised Jesus from the dead.

As our Catholic Church teaches, the death and resurrection of Jesus is the single most important event in the history of the entire universe – even more important than creation itself. Jesus being raised from the dead gives us, not just hope, but also direction, purpose, meaning, and a sense of oneness with all others and with all of creation. We’re all in this together.

Everything I have stated so far is what our Catholic faith teaches us, but the real question, as stated in the title of this message, is the one I have for each of you: “What does the resurrection of Jesus mean to you? In other words, do you believe – deep down in your soul – that Jesus rose from the dead? And, if you do believe it, what impact does it have in your life? Does it give you hope, direction, purpose, meaning, and a sense of oneness with all others and with all of creation? I hope so.

On the other hand, it is very normal, human and okay to struggle to believe, to question and even to doubt Jesus’ resurrection – or any other belief we have as Catholics – I sometimes struggle in my faith too. Still, if you don’t believe in Jesus’ resurrection, or, if it really has not had much impact in your life, then I invite you to get down on your knees, open your heart to Jesus and ask him to help you believe, accept and live his risen life. Then, with time and God’s help, you too will come to know that, out of struggle, failure, chaos and death, there will always be new life and new possibilities because Jesus rose from the dead.

### Un Mensaje de Padre Roberto

#### ¿Qué significa para usted la resurrección de Jesús?

Estamos terminando la tercera semana de la temporada de Pascua de siete semanas y, tal vez, te estarás preguntando por qué la Iglesia dedica tanto tiempo a la Pascua. La respuesta se encuentra en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica que llama a la resurrección de Jesús la “verdad culminante de nuestra fe en Cristo (#638)” y llama a la Pascua la “Fiesta de las fiestas (#1169)”. ¿Por qué? Porque la resurrección de Jesús es el fundamento sobre el cual se construyeron nuestra Iglesia Católica y nuestra fe cristiana. A pesar de todos sus asombrosos milagros, increíble compasión e impresionantes enseñanzas, si Jesús no hubiera resucitado de entre los muertos, no habría cristianismo ni cristianos. Jesús simplemente habría sido otro profeta judío que fue asesinado por su mensaje desafiante.

La resurrección de Jesús confirma su declaración de que él no era solo un profeta, sino el Mesías largamente esperado y el Hijo de Dios. Debido a que Jesús murió y resucitó, nuestros pecados son perdonados y hemos recibido el regalo de la vida eterna. Si Jesús no hubiera resucitado de entre los muertos, en el mejor de los casos seríamos como judíos religiosos que todavía esperan al Mesías.

Otro resultado importante de la resurrección de Jesús es que nos prueba que el amor es más fuerte que el odio, que el bien vence al mal, que la gracia vence al pecado y que la vida vence a la muerte, no solo al final de nuestras vidas, sino incluso ahora. Eso significa que la resurrección de Jesús no es simplemente un evento histórico que tuvo lugar hace 2000 años por el cual nos reunimos todos los años y gritamos “¡Hurra por Jesús!” Es el fundamento de la esperanza en nuestras vidas. La realidad es que la Pascua no se trata solo de Jesús; más bien, se trata de todos nosotros los seres humanos y, de hecho, de toda la creación porque la resurrección de Jesús es nuestra garantía de que Dios convertirá todas nuestras crucifixiones humanas en resurrección, y toda muerte a lo largo de la creación en nueva vida. Entonces, no importa qué cosa horrible suceda en nuestras vidas hoy o mañana, Dios nos ayudará a salir adelante, incluida la guerra en Ucrania o la guerra y el conflicto en cualquier lugar, la pandemia en curso y todos sus efectos, cualquier desastre natural que se presente, o cualquier problema personal que tengamos que soportar en nuestras vidas. Y la razón por la que sabemos que Dios nos ayudará es porque Dios resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos.

Como enseña nuestra Iglesia Católica, la muerte y resurrección de Jesús es el evento más importante en la historia de todo el universo, incluso más importante que la creación misma. Jesús resucitado de entre los muertos nos da, no solo esperanza, sino también dirección, propósito, significado y un sentido de unidad con todos los demás y con toda la creación. Estamos todos juntos en esto.

Todo lo que he dicho hasta ahora es lo que nos enseña nuestra fe católica, pero la verdadera pregunta, como dice el título de este mensaje, es la que tengo para cada uno de ustedes: “¿Qué significa para ti la resurrección de Jesús? En otras palabras, ¿crees, en el fondo de tu alma, que Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos? Y, si lo crees, ¿qué impacto tiene en tu vida? ¿Te da esperanza, dirección, propósito, significado y un sentido de unidad con todos los demás y con toda la creación? Eso espero.

Por otro lado, es muy normal, humano y está bien luchar para creer, cuestionar e incluso dudar de la resurrección de Jesús, o cualquier otra creencia que tengamos como católicos – a veces yo también lucho en mi fe. Aun así, si no crees en la resurrección de Jesús, o si realmente no ha tenido mucho impacto en tu vida, entonces te invito a ponerte de rodillas, abrir tu corazón a Jesús y pedirle que te ayude a creer, aceptar y vivir su vida resucitada. Entonces, con el tiempo y la ayuda de Dios, tú también sabrás que, de la lucha, el fracaso, el caos y la muerte, siempre habrá nueva vida y nuevas posibilidades porque Jesús resucitó de entre los muertos.
