Marawi City Second Collection Since the coordinated attack in Marawi City, Philippines by foreign ISIS fighters and the homegrown Muslim extremist Maute Group, over 100 troops and 45 civilians have lost their lives. Hundreds of thousands of citizens have fled the city and are living in temporary camps in towns surrounding Marawi. Martial law may be extended in the region until the end of this year. In response to the humanitarian crisis, we will take up a second collection at the end of the Masses on August 5-6. The proceeds will be sent to Caritas Filipinas, the development, advocacy and humanitarian arm of the Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines, in response to the Bishops' solidarity appeal for Marawi evacuees.

Pastor's Corner

This past week five members of our parish and I went to Colorado Springs to attend a conference on evangeliza-

tion offered by the Catherine of Siena Institute. I was joined by Sr. Joyanne Sullivan, SND, Randy and Patricia De Vera, Fr. Francis Goode, OP, and Darlene Finochiarro. Attending the conference were priests, religious and lay people from Texas, Louisiana, Colorado, Connecticut, Minnesota, Ohio, and even Barbados!

The conference focused on learning about thresholds of conversion that people cross on the way to becoming disciples of Jesus, and utilizing the understanding of the conversion process to evangelize in the context of real, trusting relationships.

This process parallels that growth in relationship between two people who become lifelong friends, or between a man and woman who choose to enter the covenant of marriage. It is based upon the experiences of many people who have gone through the process of conversion to Jesus Christ. It recognizes that faith is fundamentally a relationship with God.

Pope St. John Paul II described conversion as a result of encountering Jesus through His own words and actions in scripture. "The proclamation of the Word of God has Christian conversion as its aim: a complete and sincere adherence to Christ and his Gospel through faith . . . Conversion means accepting, by a personal decision, the saving sovereignty of Christ and becoming his disciple."

This is the perennial work of the Church, of each parish, and even of each Christian. My hope is that our renovated community center will be a place where we can not only offer events to help people encounter Jesus, but also a center where we can form His disciples to help others make the journey to faith in Him.

Pero, ¿fue un sueño? ¿Fue algo real? ¿O fue solamente un mito astuto?

¡Pedro no guiere que su visión sea confundida de igual manera! Nos cuenta el Evangelio de san Marcos lo que él y sus amigos Santiago y Juan vieron cuando subieron un día a la montaña con Jesús. Jesús les ordenó a los tres testigos que no dijeran nada hasta que "el Hijo del Hombre resucitara de entre los muertos" (Marcos 9:9). Por si los lectores del Evangelio dan por descontada la historia o simplemente la descartan como un mito piadoso, Pedro escribe su propia versión de la Transfiguración de Jesús en su segunda carta a la Iglesia. Escribe con autoridad, como testigo ocular. 
