PASTOR'S CORNER

The day of Pentecost is seven weeks after Easter Sunday: in other words, the fiftieth day after Easter inclusive of Easter Sunday. Because Easter itself has no fixed date, this makes Pentecost a changeable holiday. That means that today, May 28, 2023, is Pentecost Sunday.

Pentecost celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ, as mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles.



The description in Acts 2 states that, after Jesus ascended into heaven, Jesus' followers were gathered together and the Holy Spirit "filled the whole house where they were sitting" (Acts 2:2). "All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them."

By receiving the Holy Spirit, the apostles became more knowing, and had a greater understanding of the mysteries of the Gospel and were more qualified to preach it to people of all nations. Those of us who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation have received the fullness of grace with the same potential of having the same knowledge and understanding that the apostles received on this Day of Pentecost. But we must actively ask for this grace and take the opportunity to gain more knowledge through our own study, especially of the New Testament. The more knowledge and understanding we have, the closer we come to Jesus and the closer we come to be devoted to Jesus as true disciples. This is what God calls us to – DISCIPLESHIP.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

El día de Pentecostés es siete semanas después del Domingo de Pascua: en otras palabras, el quincuagésimo día después de Pascua, incluido el Domingo de Pascua. Debido a que la Pascua en sí misma no tiene una fecha fija, esto hace que Pentecostés sea una fiesta cambiante. Eso significa que hoy, 28 de mayo de 2023, es el domingo de Pentecostés.

Pentecostés celebra el descenso del Espíritu Santo sobre los Apóstoles y otros seguidores de Jesucristo, como se menciona en el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles.



La descripción en Hechos 2 dice que, después de que Jesús ascendió al cielo, los seguidores de Jesús fueron reunidos y el Espíritu Santo "llenó toda la casa donde estaban sentados" (Hechos 2: 2). "Todos ellos fueron llenos del Espíritu Santo y comenzaron a hablar en otras lenguas a medida que el Espíritu los capacitaba".

Al recibir el Espíritu Santo, los apóstoles se volvieron más conocedores, y tenían una mayor comprensión de los misterios del Evangelio y estaban más calificados para predicarlo a personas de todas las naciones. Aquellos de nosotros que hemos recibido el Sacramento de la Confirmación hemos recibido la plenitud de la gracia con el mismo potencial de tener el mismo conocimiento y comprensión que los apóstoles recibieron en este Día de Pentecostés. Pero debemos pedir activamente esta gracia y aprovechar la oportunidad para obtener más conocimiento a través de nuestro propio estudio, especialmente del Nuevo Testamento. Cuanto más conocimiento y entendimiento tenemos, más nos acercamos a Jesús y más nos acercamos a ser devotos de Jesús como verdaderos discípulos. Esto es a lo que Dios nos llama – DISCIPULADO.

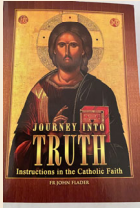

Journey to Catholic Shrines East Coast, USA and Eastern Canada
