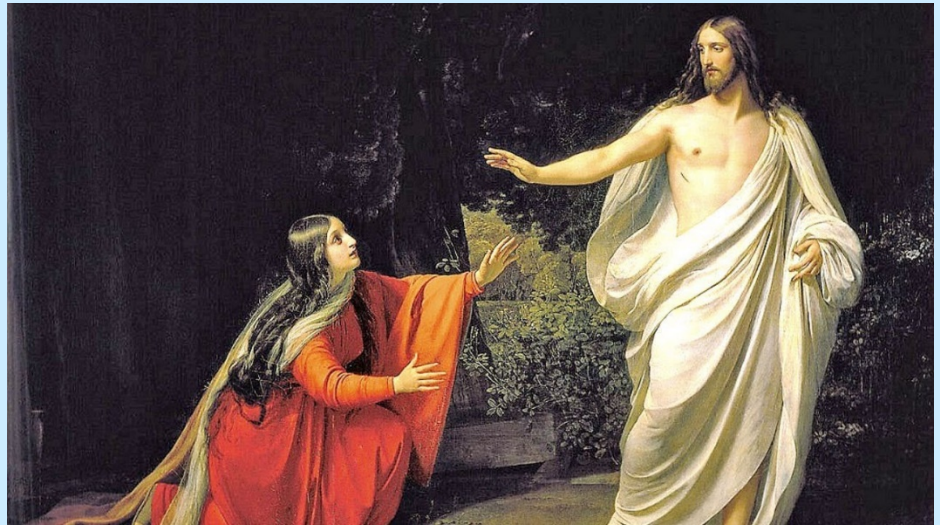
Altar Server Ministry:

PASTOR'S CORNER

Who was Mary Magdalene? "Apostle of the Apostles" is the title given Mary Magdalene by St Thomas Aquinas. St Luke the Evangelist tells us, in Chapter 8 of his Gospel, how Jesus went from town to town announcing the Good News of the Kingdom of God, and how the Twelve Apostles were with Him together with



some women who had been healed of evil spirits or infirmities and were serving them. Among these was a certain "Mary, called the Magdalene, from whom seven demons came out."

Contrary to many assumptions, Mary Magdalene was not a prostitute. She may have had demons of physical or moral infirmities, but Jesus cast them out

Mary Magdalene was the first to announce the joyful message of Easter That Jesus had risen. But she also was among those who loved Him most when she stood at the foot of the Cross together with Mary, His Mother, and the disciple, St. John. She did not deny him or run away in fear as the other disciples did, but remained close to Him every moment, up to and including the tomb.

The Dominican St. Thomas Aquinas certainly had it right in saying that Mary Magdalene was indeed the Apostle to the Apostles! The Feast of Mary Magdalene will be this Saturday, July 22.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

¿Quién fue María Magdalena? "Apóstol de los Apóstoles" es el título dado a María Magdalena por Santo Tomás de Aquino. San Lucas evangelista nos cuenta, en el capítulo 8 de su Evangelio, cómo Jesús iba de pueblo en pueblo anunciando la Buena Nueva del Reino de Dios, y cómo los Doce Apóstoles estaban con Él junto con algunas mujeres que habían sido sanadas de malos espíritus o enfermedades y les estaban sirviendo. Entre ellos estaba una cierta "María, llamada Magdalena, de quien salieron siete demonios".



Contrariamente a muchas suposiciones, María Magdalena no era una prostituta. Ella pudo haber tenido demonios de enfermedades físicas o morales, pero Jesús los echó fuera. María Magdalena fue la primera en anunciar el alegre mensaje de la Pascua de que Jesús había resucitado. Pero también estaba entre los que más lo amaban cuando estaba al pie de la Cruz junto con María, su Madre, y el discípulo, San Juan. Ella no lo negó ni huyó con miedo como lo hicieron los otros discípulos, sino que permaneció cerca de Él en todo momento, incluyendo la tumba.

¡El dominico Santo Tomás de Aquino ciertamente tenía razón al decir que María Magdalena era realmente la Apóstol de los Apóstoles! La fiesta de María Magdalena será este sábado 22 de julio.
