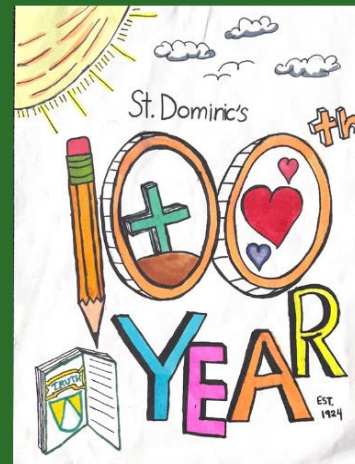
Counseling Services

The purpose of our program and the counselor's activities will be to engage students in settings accomplishing short and long-term academic and personal goals to improve grades and attendance and to decrease disruptive or counterproductive behavior.
