We will be hosting a Halloween Event on October 27th!



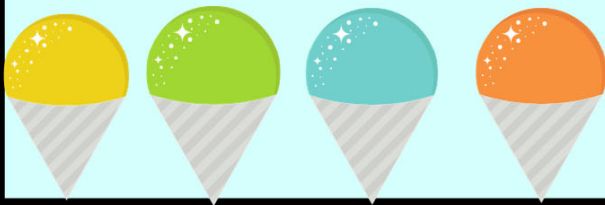
## Technology Tuesdays

One of our major goals this year is to raise funds for a new computer lab.

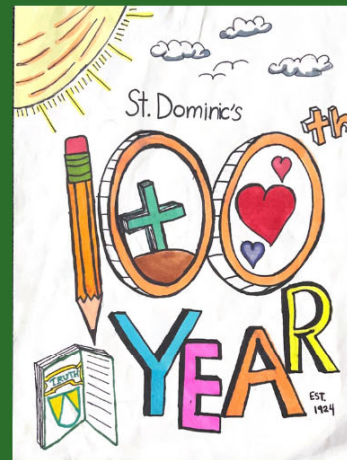
For the month of October

## PASTOR'S CORNER

On Tuesday, September 26, at 12:30 PM, four new bishops will be ordained for 4 of the 5 regions of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. For the first time in several years, we will now have an auxiliary bishop for each region. These four have been chosen from the priests of Los Angeles. St. Dominic's is located in the San Fernando Region of the Archdiocese, and our new regional bishop will be **Msgr. Albert Bahhuth**.

"Msgr. Bahhuth grew up in Beirut, Lebanon, but immigrated to the U.S. at age 20 to study chemical engineering at the University of Missouri. After receiving a Ph.D. from the University of Mississippi, he taught chemical engineering at the University of Wyoming before moving in 1984 to Los Angeles, where he worked in the retail and fast-food industries, including owning a Subway franchise.

Bahhuth entered St. John's Seminary in 1991. He was ordained in 1996 and served as pastor of St. Finbar in Burbank (2002-2013) and St. Kateri Tekakwitha in Santa Clarita (2013-2015). He was named vicar general and moderator of the curia by Archbishop Gomez in 2015, until 2020. He has served as pastor at Holy Family, South Pasadena since 2021." (Angelus, July 18, 2023)

## LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

El martes 26 de septiembre, a las 12:30 PM, cuatro nuevos obispos serán ordenados para 4 de las 5 regiones de la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles. Por primera vez en varios años, ahora tendremos un obispo auxiliar para cada región. Estos cuatro han sido elegidos entre los sacerdotes de Los Ángeles. Santo Domingo se encuentra en la Región de San Fernando de la Arquidiócesis, y nuestro nuevo obispo regional será **Monseñor Albert Bahhuth**.

"Msgr. Bahhuth creció en Beirut, Líbano, pero emigró a los Estados Unidos a los 20 años para estudiar ingeniería química en la Universidad de Missouri. Después de recibir un Ph.D. de la Universidad de Mississippi, enseñó ingeniería química en la Universidad de Wyoming antes de mudarse en 1984 a Los Ángeles, donde trabajó en las industrias minorista y de comida rápida, incluida la propiedad de una franquicia de Subway.

Bahhuth ingresó al Seminario de San Juan en 1991. Fue ordenado en 1996 y sirvió como párroco de St. Finbar en Burbank (2002-2013) y St. Kateri Tekakwitha en Santa Clarita (2013-2015). Fue nombrado vicario general y moderador de la curia por el arzobispo Gómez en 2015, hasta 2020. Ha servido como pastor en Holy Family, South Pasadena desde 2021". (Ángelus, 18 de julio de 2023)
