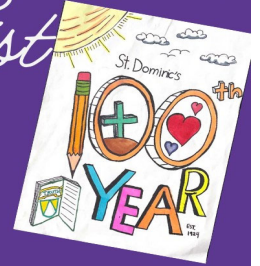

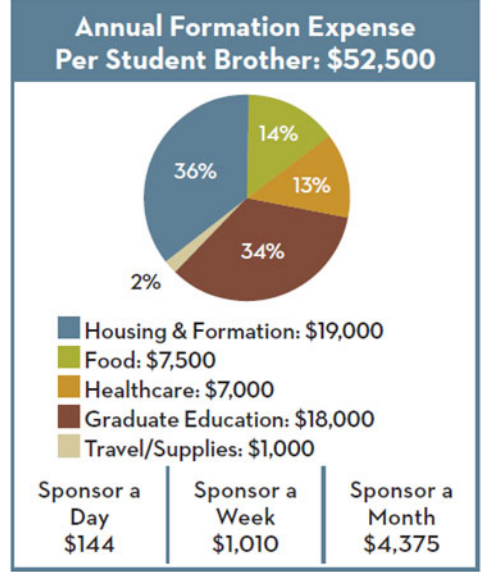
Funds support Dominican Student Brother housing, food, formation, education, travel/supplies and healthcare expenses. Our need for this year is \$1,800,000 .

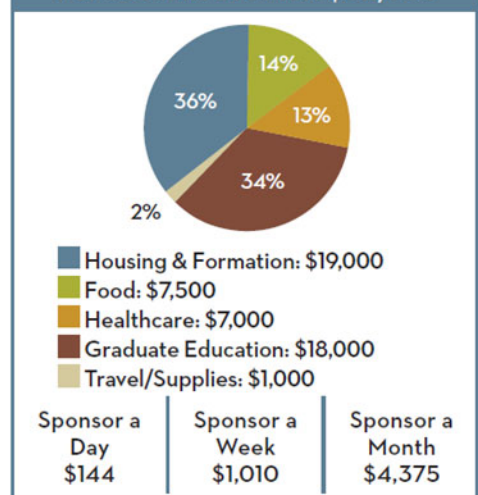
