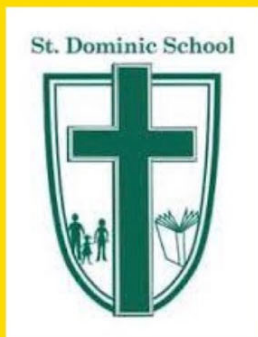

PASTOR'S CORNER

Our culture is less and less a Christian culture, and this is the intention of many in our secular society today. To change this will require more gifted preachers to proclaim the truth with charity and clarity. The Dominicans are prepared to respond, and one way is to work for more vocations to the Dominican Order and to our Western Dominican Province. Vocations continue to increase, and we now have 41 men in formation: 9 Novice Brothers and 32 Dominican Student Brothers (seminarians). These are the men who will be responding to the evangelization needs of our generation and the next.

As our vocations increase, as they have over the last several years, our need for your help increases, to fund their academic, spiritual, and human formation. As Fr. Isaiah Mary and Br. Xavier Marie explained last weekend, the cost per year per brother is about \$52,500 with an annual budget of about \$1,800,000.



For those who have already given a donation for our Annual Rosary Sunday Appeal, thank you so very much. For those who have not yet done so, thank you very much for your consideration. We rely entirely on friends like you, which is why your help is so important. This is an investment for the future of the Church, for the Dominican Order, for St. Dominic Church, and for our society.

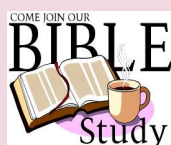
