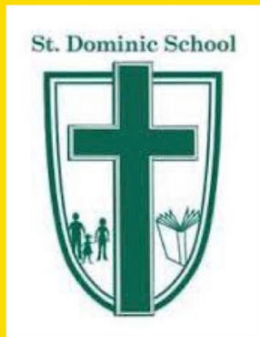

PASTOR'S CORNER

I was blessed to be able to attend the ordination of the new bishop of Fairbanks, Alaska, the Most Reverend Steve Maekawa. Bishop Steve is a Dominican from our Western Dominican Province. He and I spent some time living together at St. Albert Priory in Oakland CA., studying at the Dominican School of Philosophy. We have worked together on a number of projects, becoming good friends over the last 27 years.

Bishop Steve was ordained in Fairbanks on Thursday, October 12. The beautiful ordination Mass was attended by two cardinals, (one of whom was Cardinal Mahoney of Los Angeles) 11 bishops, about 31 Dominicans (who flew to Fairbanks to support our Dominican brother and are pictured in the Cathedral with Bishop Steve), and nearly all the priests from Anchorage and Fairbanks. Bishop Steve had been pastor of the Old Cathedral of Holy Family in downtown Anchorage for 7 years.



The Diocese of Fairbanks is 2/3 of the state of Alaska (pictured in green), the largest land mass diocese in the United States, and one of the poorest. Only 8 of the 46 parishes and mission churches are financially self-sustaining. The remaining income needed to run the diocese comes from donations from across the United States. Of the 46 parishes, only 9 are accessible by road. The others must be approached by plane, boat, or snowmobile. There are only 21 priests in the diocese, and 18 of them are missionary priests from other dioceses in the U.S. and from foreign countries.

Pray for Bishop Steve as he begins the difficult ministry that is before him.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

Tuve la bendición de poder asistir a la ordenación del nuevo obispo de Fairbanks, Alaska, el Reverendísimo Steve Maekawa. El Obispo Steve es un dominico de nuestra Provincia Dominicana Occidental. Él y yo pasamos algún tiempo viviendo juntos en el Priorato de San Alberto en Oakland, California, estudiando en la Escuela Dominicana de Filosofía. Hemos trabajado juntos en varios proyectos, convirtiéndonos en buenos amigos durante los últimos 27 años.

El Obispo Steve fue ordenado en Fairbanks el jueves 12 de octubre. A la hermosa misa de ordenación asistieron dos cardenales (uno de los cuales era el cardenal Mahoney de Los Ángeles), 11 obispos, unos 31 dominicos (que volaron a Fairbanks para apoyar a nuestro hermano dominico y están fotografiados en la catedral con el obispo Steve) y casi todos los sacerdotes de Anchorage y Fairbanks. El Obispo Steve había sido párroco de la Antigua Catedral de la Sagrada Familia en el centro de Anchorage durante 7 años.



La Diócesis de Fairbanks es 2/3 del estado de Alaska (en la foto en verde), la diócesis de masa de tierra más grande de los Estados Unidos y una de las más pobres. Solo 8 de las 46 parroquias e iglesias misioneras son financieramente autosuficientes. El resto de los ingresos necesarios para el funcionamiento de la diócesis provienen de donaciones de todo Estados Unidos. De las 46 parroquias, solo 9 son accesibles por carretera. A los demás hay que acercarse en avión, barco o moto de nieve. Solo hay 21 sacerdotes en la diócesis, y 18 de ellos son sacerdotes misioneros de otras diócesis en los Estados Unidos y de países extranjeros.

Oremos por el Obispo Steve al comenzar el difícil ministerio que tiene por delante.

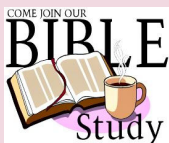
