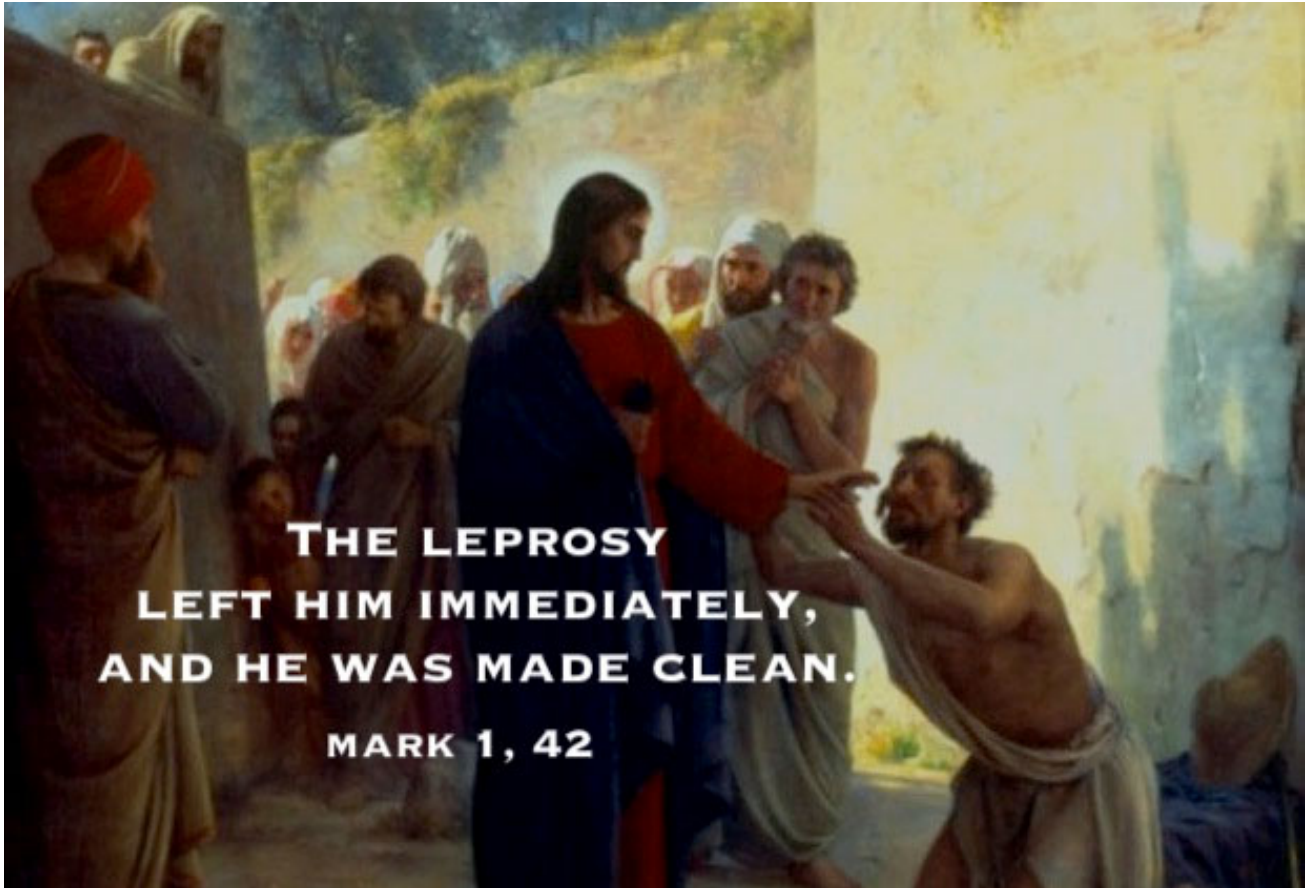

I arrived to begin my second assignment as Pastor at St. Dominic's on October 1, 2022. Our country, and indeed the world, was still coming out of the period of the COVID-19 pandemic and moving into what is now called the COVID-19 endemic. Our parish here in Eagle Rock was in the process of moving away from the pandemic and trying to bring back programs and ministries that had not been able to operate during the extreme shut-down periods of 2020-2021. We are still in that process and ministries and activities are slowly returning.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday Fasting

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday Fasting: Members of the Catholic Church are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. For members of the Catholic Church, this fasting is obligatory from age 18 until age 59. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstaining from meat for Catholics from age 14 and up.

On Fridays during Lent, we will pray the stations of the Cross ca. 6:30 PM, right after the 6:00 PM Mass. During the Stations of the Cross, confession will be available. We will also have soup and bread dinner after the Stations of the Cross.

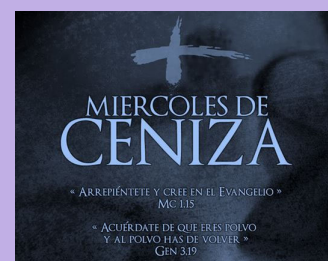
