This year’s theme is “Comfort in the Passion of Christ”. Brochures are available in the parish office. You can download the Mater Dolorosa app to your phone.

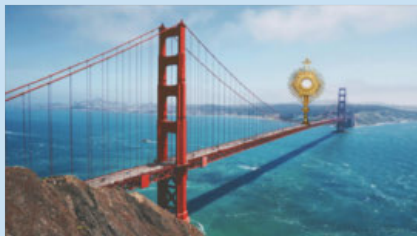

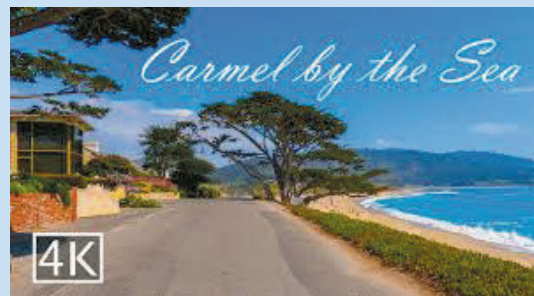
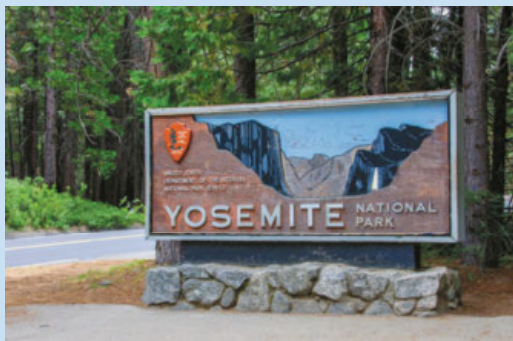

PASTOR’S CORNER:

Next Sunday, March 10, the Church celebrates Laetare Sunday, or Rejoice Sunday. The day’s theme comes from the entrance antiphon next Sunday reflecting on Isaiah 66:10-11: “Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exalt and be satisfied at her consoling breast.” It is also a good time to think about where we in our faith renewal.

Laetare is the first word — meaning “rejoice” — in the Latin text. On Laetare Sunday the Church expresses hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten fasts and penances. The change in color from Violet to Rose indicates a glimpse of the joy that awaits us at Easter, just before we enter into the somber days of the Passiontide of Holy Week.



Laetare Sunday is the Church’s way of giving us a relief before we approach the darkness and horror of the days through Good Friday and Holy Saturday. It’s an opportunity to keep in the back of our minds what awaits us on Easter Sunday — the reality that Jesus Christ is risen from the dead, and that our hearts will always be filled with joy and grace!

CONFESSION OFFERED: Speaking of grace, take the opportunity come into the state of grace with attending the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession), offered at St. Dominic’s Fridays of Lent during the Stations of the Cross and Saturday, 3:30 – 4:30 and Sunday in English or Spanish at 12:30 – 1:00. LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR:

El próximo domingo, 10 de marzo, la Iglesia celebra el Domingo Laetare, o Domingo del Regocijo. El tema del día proviene de la antífona de entrada del próximo domingo que reflexiona sobre Isaías 66:10-11: "Alégrate, Jerusalén, y todos los que la aman. Alégrese todos los que estaban de luto; exalta y siéntete satisfecho de su consolador pecho". También es un buen momento para pensar en dónde nos encontramos en nuestra renovación de la fe.

Laetare es la primera palabra, que significa "regocijarse", en el texto latino. En el Domingo Laetare, la Iglesia expresa esperanza y alegría en medio de nuestros ayunos y penitencias cuaresmales. El cambio de color del violeta al rosa indica un atisbo de la alegría que nos espera en la Pascua, justo antes de entrar en los días sombríos de la Pasión de la Semana Santa.

El Domingo Laetare es la forma en que la Iglesia nos da un alivio antes de que nos acerquemos a la oscuridad y el horror de los días del Viernes Santo y el Sábado Santo. Es una oportunidad para mantener en el fondo de nuestras mentes lo que nos espera el Domingo de Pascua --- la realidad de que Jesucristo ha resucitado de entre los muertos y que nuestros corazones siempre estarán llenos de alegría y gracia.
