

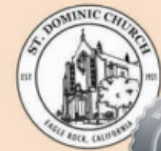
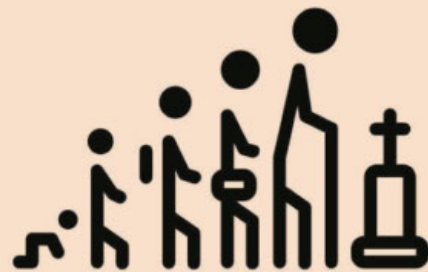

PASTOR'S CORNER

In this Easter Season, called Eastertide, we should think back to our experience of the Triduum at the end of last month. I would like to share a beautiful reflection from Heather Tanning who was baptized into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil, March 30, 2024. This reflection should inspire us and renew our faith.

"Every moment of Holy Saturday 2024 affirmed my decision to follow the Catholic faith. Most importantly, it affirmed my decision to make St. Dominic's my parish. Receiving the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and my First Holy Communion has forever changed my life.



My fears of being in front of the congregation during the Easter Vigil were quickly eased as I was surrounded by the love and support of Sister Joyanne Sullivan, Yvette Richardson, and Darlene Finocchiaro, our RCIA Team. Sitting in the first pew, in the light of the fire, listening to the words of Father Peter, Father Isaiah, and all the lectors, I fully understood the gift God offers as our refuge and strength. Upon rising from the Baptismal font, Father Peter and all of the parishioners warmly welcomed me into the Catholic faith. Father Peter's words and smile held within them God's salvation and I was humbled in a manner words cannot express.

Upon reentering the church, warm and dry, in the wake of my Baptism, I felt the grace and mercy of the Lord around me. I am deeply grateful for this moving experience and even more grateful for the hope and direction it has given to my life. The congratulatory hugs and handshakes from my fellow parishioners were further blessings to end a perfect ceremony.

While I am still learning and discovering aspects of the faith, to be now officially part of the Catholic church gives me a home I have never known, a family I have never had, a future I have never recognized until now. The church activities leading up to and through Easter were replete with new experiences that were at times overwhelming. However, the love and support that enveloped me throughout has touched my heart and quieted my soul in such a way that reaffirms, *I have truly found Christ.*" – Heather Tanning

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

En este tiempo de Resurrección, llamado "Pascual", debemos recordar nuestra experiencia del Triduo a finales del mes pasado. Me gustaría compartir una hermosa reflexión de Heather Tanning, quien fue bautizada en la Iglesia Católica en la Vigilia Pascual, el 30 de marzo de 2024. Esta reflexión debe inspirarnos y renovar nuestra fe.

"Cada momento del Sábado Santo de 2024 afirmó mi decisión de seguir la fe católica. Lo más importante es que afirmó mi decisión de hacer de Santo Domingo mi parroquia. Recibir los sacramentos del Bautismo, la Confirmación y mi Primera Comunión ha cambiado mi vida para siempre.



Mis temores de estar frente a la congregación durante la Vigilia Pascual se aliviaron rápidamente cuando estuve rodeada por el amor y el apoyo de la Hermana Joyanne Sullivan, Yvette Richardson y Darlene Finocchiaro, del equipo de RICA. Al levantarme de la fuente bautismal, el Padre Peter y todos los feligreses me dieron una cálida bienvenida a la fe católica. Las palabras y la sonrisa del padre Pedro contenían en su interior la salvación de Dios y me sentí humilde de una manera que las palabras no pueden expresar.

Al volver a entrar en la iglesia, cálida y seca, después de mi bautismo, sentí la gracia y la misericordia del Señor a mi alrededor. Estoy profundamente agradecida por esta conmovedora experiencia y aún más agradecida por la esperanza y la dirección que le ha dado a mi vida. Los abrazos de felicitación y los apretones de manos de mis compañeros feligreses fueron otras bendiciones para terminar una ceremonia perfecta.

Si bien todavía estoy aprendiendo y descubriendo aspectos de la fe, ser ahora oficialmente parte de la iglesia católica me da un hogar que nunca he conocido, una familia que nunca he tenido, un futuro que nunca he reconocido hasta ahora. Las actividades de la iglesia que condujeron a la Pascua y durante ella estuvieron repletas de nuevas experiencias que a veces fueron abrumadoras.
