PASTOR'S CORNER

In the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen. This is a prayer that we say nearly every day if we pray every day. We say it so often, we don't even think about it, but we are blessing ourselves in the name of the Holy Trinity. It is very difficult for us to fully understand with only our minds, using only our reasoning skills. It takes a leap of faith, as the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches in paragraph 234:



234. The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith.

The Trinity has been revealed to us since last Christmas when the Son of God, Jesus, was born to live among us. Then after He was baptized, God's voice was heard, "This is my beloved Son in whom I am well pleased." Here we have two persons of the Trinity, God the Father and God the Son. Then last weekend the third person of the Trinity was revealed to the apostles and to us when the Holy Spirit descended upon them on Pentecost. The Holy Trinity could never have been known to us unless God had not revealed himself as three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, in one God. God has revealed the Holy Trinity to us. Now we have to ask for the strong faith to believe in the Trinity and call upon the Trinity to bless us and strengthen us every time we make the sign of the Cross.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

En el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. Amén. Esta es una oración que decimos casi todos los días, si es que oramos todos los días. Lo decimos tan a menudo, que ni siquiera pensamos en ello, pero nos estamos bendiciendo a nosotros mismos en el nombre de la Santísima Trinidad. Es muy difícil para nosotros entender completamente solo con nuestras mentes, usando solo nuestras habilidades de razonamiento. Se necesita un salto de fe, como enseña el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica en el párrafo 234:



234. El misterio de la Santísima Trinidad es el misterio central de la fe y de la vida cristiana. Es el misterio de Dios mismo. Es, por tanto, la fuente de todos los demás misterios de la fe, la luz que los ilumina. Es la enseñanza más fundamental y esencial en la jerarquía de las verdades de la fe.

La Trinidad nos ha sido revelada desde la Navidad pasada, cuando el Hijo de Dios, Jesús, nació para vivir entre nosotros. Luego, después de ser bautizado, se escuchó la voz de Dios: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo complacencia". Aquí tenemos a dos personas de la Trinidad, Dios Padre y Dios Hijo. Luego, el fin de semana pasado, la tercera persona de la Trinidad fue revelada a los apóstoles y a nosotros cuando el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre ellos en Pentecostés.

La Santísima Trinidad nunca podría haber sido conocida por nosotros a menos que Dios no se hubiera revelado a sí mismo como tres personas, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, en un solo Dios. Dios nos ha revelado la Santísima Trinidad. Ahora tenemos que pedir la fe fuerte para creer en la Trinidad e invocar a la Trinidad para que nos bendiga y nos fortalezca cada vez que hagamos la señal de la cruz.
