The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus month

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of June to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This tradition dates back to the 17th century when St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun, had visions of Jesus Christ revealing His Sacred Heart to her. In the apparitions, Jesus gives these 12 promises for those who are devoted to His Sacred Heart.



1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their families.
3. I will console them in their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assure refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.
5. I will pour abundant blessing on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes where the image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give the priest the power of touching the most heartened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of my Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my pleasure, no without receiving their Sacraments; My shall be their assure refuge at that last hour.

Pastor's Corner

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) proclaimed a three-year promotion called The National Eucharistic Revival, to begin on Corpus Christi Sunday, 2022. This program was designed to proclaim to Catholics everywhere that The Holy Eucharist is the Body of Jesus who is truly present in the host that is given at Holy Communion at each Mass. Studies have shown that a large percentage of Catholics have doubts about this or just don't believe it, thinking that the round host that they receive at communion is simply bread that is a symbol of Jesus. NOT TRUE!

The bread and wine at the beginning of Mass are placed on the altar and during the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest consecrates the bread and wine and they become the body and blood of Jesus. Jesus himself established the Holy Eucharist at the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, when at supper Jesus took bread, broke it and passed it around to all the apostles saying, "Take this bread, and eat it. This is my body which will be given up for you." Then he took a chalice of wine and passed it around to all the apostles, saying, "Take this and drink from it. This is my blood which will be poured out for you."

This is a great mystery of the Church, a mystery that takes faith to believe, but is rooted in the Gospels as established by Jesus. This is the core of our Catholic faith that is to be believed by all of us.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) proclamó una promoción de tres años llamada El Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional, que comenzaría el domingo de Corpus Christi de 2022. Este programa fue diseñado para proclamar a los católicos de todo el mundo que la Sagrada Eucaristía es el Cuerpo de Jesús que está verdaderamente presente en la hostia que se da en la Sagrada Comunión en cada Misa. Los estudios han demostrado que un gran porcentaje de católicos tienen dudas sobre esto o simplemente no lo creen, pensando que la hostia redonda que reciben en la comunión es simplemente pan o es un símbolo de Jesús. ¡NO ES VERDAD!

El pan y el vino al comienzo de la Misa se colocan en el altar y durante la Plegaria Eucarística, el sacerdote consagra el pan y el vino y se convierten en el cuerpo y la sangre de Jesús. Jesús mismo estableció la Sagrada Eucaristía en la Última Cena del Jueves Santo, cuando en la cena Jesús tomó el pan, lo partió y lo pasó a todos los apóstoles diciendo: "Tomen este pan y cómanlo. Este es mi cuerpo, que será entregado por vosotros". Luego tomó un cáliz de vino y lo repartió entre todos los apóstoles, diciendo: "Tomen esto y beban de él. Esta es mi sangre, que será derramada por vosotros".

Este es un gran misterio de la Iglesia, un misterio que requiere fe para creer, pero que tiene sus raíces en los Evangelios establecidos por Jesús. Este es el núcleo de nuestra fe católica que debe ser creído por todos nosotros.
