

Pastor's Corner

- 75% of children will continue to attend Mass as adults if their father is active in his faith and attends Mass regularly with his family.
- 2% of children will continue to attend Mass as adults if only the mother is active in her faith, and the father is absent from church. (National Catholic Register, Lent 2024).

Whether a child will remain a Catholic and will attend Sunday Mass and participate in



the life of the Church, is significantly affected by the religious practice of the father. A Catholic father's greatest duty is to lead his spouse and children to receive the Holy Eucharist in the Mass on Sundays *and* holy days of obligation. These Fathers will have a lasting impact.

Children eventually make the connection between the faith of their father and what it does to him. If Dad takes faith in God seriously then the message to their children is that God should be taken seriously. A father's impact on their children's faith and practice is HUGE.

On this Father's Day, reflect on your role as a leader of faith and discern how you might become more active in the church and how to grow in your faith to increase the faith of your family.
