The devotion to the First Friday of each month is for The Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our Lord appeared to [St. Margaret Mary Alocoque](#) (1647-1690), and gave her the special task to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart Jesus asked for special prayers to make reparation for this great neglect to the proper reverence owed to God. For those who did this faithfully, he made the "Great Promise" which was the last of the Twelve Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

He said to her, "I promise you in the unfathomable mercy of my heart that my omnipotent love will procure the grace of final penitence for all those who receive communion on nine successive first Fridays of the month; they will not die in my disfavor, or without having received the sacraments, since my divine heart will be their sure refuge in the last moments of their life."

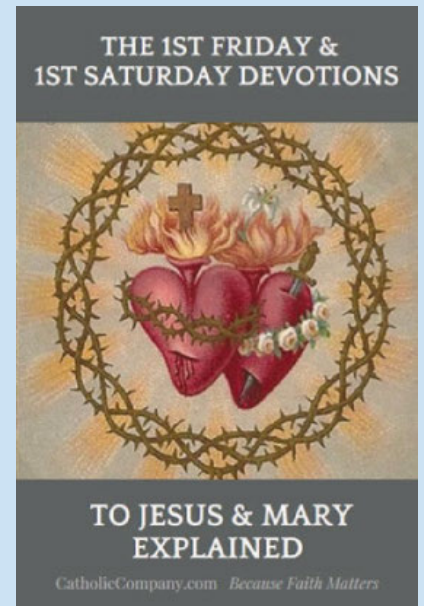
To receive this gift of grace you must receive be in the state of grace having made confession and make reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for all the sinfulness and ingratitude of men.

The practice of the First Saturday devotion was requested by

[Our Lady of Fatima](#), who appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, in 1917.

She said to Lucia, "On the First Saturday of every month for five months, reparation be made in atonement for the sins of the world. People pierce me at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. I promise to assist at the hour of death, all those who shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the rosary, and keep me company for 15 minutes while meditating on the 15 mysteries of the rosary, with the intention of making reparation to me."

Join our many parishioners who already celebrate this monthly devotion, on the First Friday and First Saturday of July, next weekend, July 5 and 6 at any of our regular daily Masses those days.

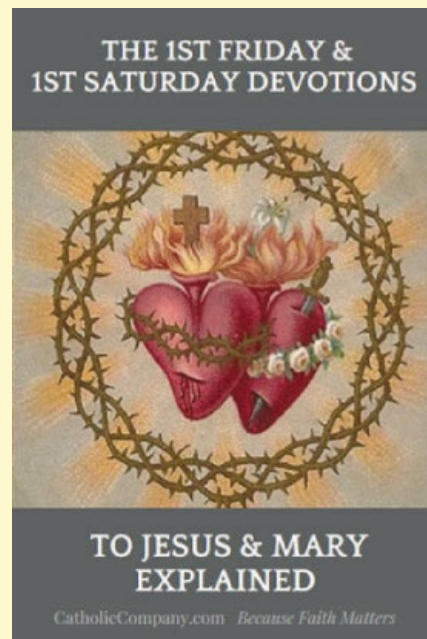

VIRTUS Classes scheduled at St. Dominic

VIRTUS classes have been scheduled as follows:

Protecting God's Children (initial three hour class)

- Saturday, July 27, 2024
- Saturday, August 17, 2024

Each of these classes will be from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. in the Parish Hall.

All attendees must be over 18; no children will be permitted in the Parish Hall.

What is VIRTUS? VIRTUS is the education program the Archdiocese of Los Angeles selected as part of its child sex abuse prevention program. The initial class, "Protecting God's Children", is a three-hour class. Certification is valid for four years, at which time you may take the recertification class, "Keeping the Promise Alive".

Who needs to take VIRTUS? Anyone over 18 involved in ministry at St. Dominic's, either on the parish campus, or in the name of the parish, needs to be VIRTUS trained. All employees of St. Dominic's parish must be VIRTUS trained. Some examples of who needs VIRTUS (**but not limited to**) include:

Ushers/hospitality ministers Lectors Choir members
Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion Sacristans Cub Scout parents
Confirmation team leaders (over 18) Catechists Boy Scout parents
Legion of Mary members FFPD Girl Scout parents
St. Vincent de Paul members LOVE Ministry School parents
Health ministry members OCIC/OCIA Blessed Sacrament Confraternity
Pastoral Council members

If you are leading an adult faith discussion group, such as a Bible Study, Light of Jesus, or the LGBTQ group, the leaders should be trained in VIRTUS.

You can register for VIRTUS by going to www.virtusonline.org. St. Dominic's is in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, San Fernando Pastoral Region. If you have previously taken a VIRTUS class, but have not kept your online account active, you will have to reactivate your account. Together, we can Protect our Youth and Vulnerable Adults!
