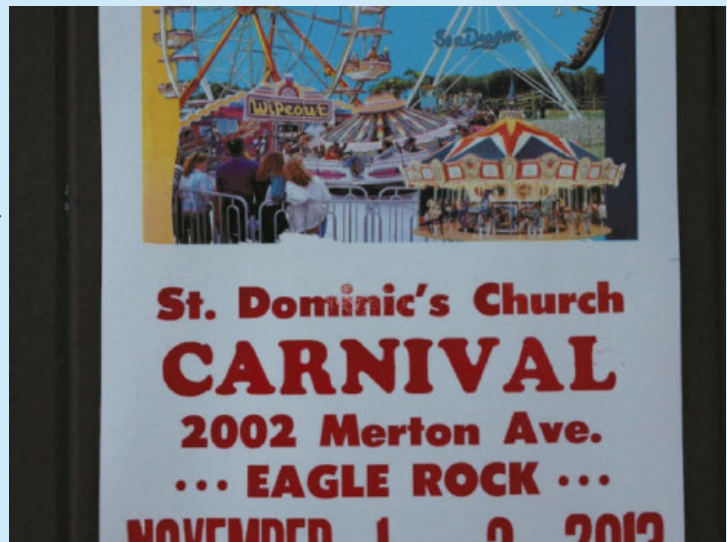

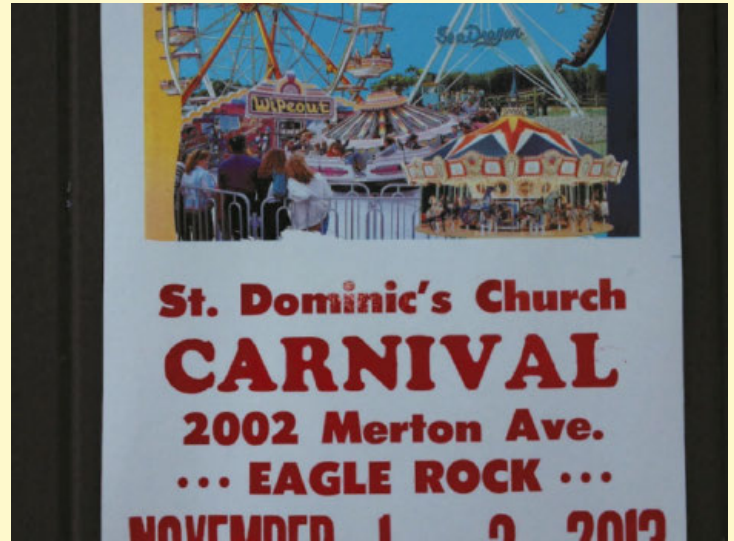
LGBTQIA+ Outreach

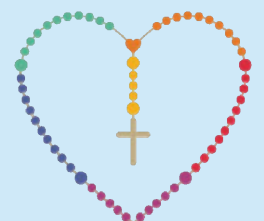
