Pastor's Corner

November 7, 1924: Signing of the documents to establish St. Dominic School in Eagle Rock as part of St. Dominic Church. November 7, 2024: we are still going strong!

In 2010, St. Dominic School enrollment reached a low of 170, but with some policy, tuition, and program changes, we stopped the decline and began a new period of growth.



The establishment of the Pre-School for three and four-year olds in March 2011 was a program change to begin to increase enrollment. The Pre-School classes filled and had waiting lists. Those large classes gradually increased the next grade levels year-by-year, and by 2015 enrollment climbed to 237, and by 2019, to 270. After the Covid pandemic hit, the school reopened with an enrollment of 240.

The important aspect of the continued success of St. Dominic School and every Catholic school is collaboration between parents, teachers, staff, principal, and pastor. St. Dominic School is the largest ministry of the parish, which means we all as a St. Dominic parish community are called to join the school community to collaborate to support the school and continue striving to achieve the excellence that we desire for all our students. Thank you for your support of the school.

7 de noviembre de 1924: Se firman los documentos para establecer la Escuela de Santo Domingo en Eagle Rock como parte de la Iglesia de Santo Domingo. 7 de noviembre de 2024: ¡seguimos fuertes!

En 2010, la matrícula de la Escuela Santo Domingo alcanzó un mínimo de 170, pero con algunos cambios en la política, la matrícula y el programa, detuvimos el declive y comenzamos un nuevo período de crecimiento.



El establecimiento de la Escuela Preescolar para niños de tres y cuatro años en marzo de 2011 fue un cambio de programa para comenzar a aumentar la matrícula. Las clases de Preescolar se llenaron y tenían listas de espera. Esas clases grandes aumentaron gradualmente los siguientes niveles de grado año tras año, y para 2015 la matrícula subió a 237, y para 2019, a 270. Después de la pandemia de Covid, la escuela reabrió con una matrícula de 240 estudiantes.

El aspecto importante del éxito continuo de la Escuela Santo Domingo y de todas las escuelas católicas es la colaboración entre los padres, los maestros, el personal, el director y el pastor. La Escuela Santo Domingo es el ministerio más grande de la parroquia, lo que significa que todos nosotros, como comunidad parroquial de Santo Domingo, estamos llamados a unirnos a la comunidad escolar para colaborar en el apoyo a la escuela y continuar esforzándonos por lograr la excelencia que deseamos para todos nuestros estudiantes. 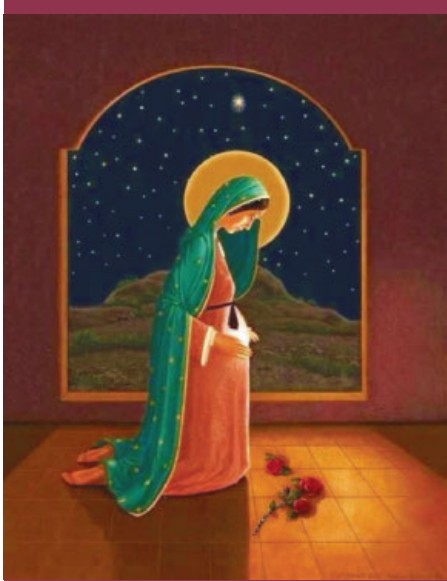
