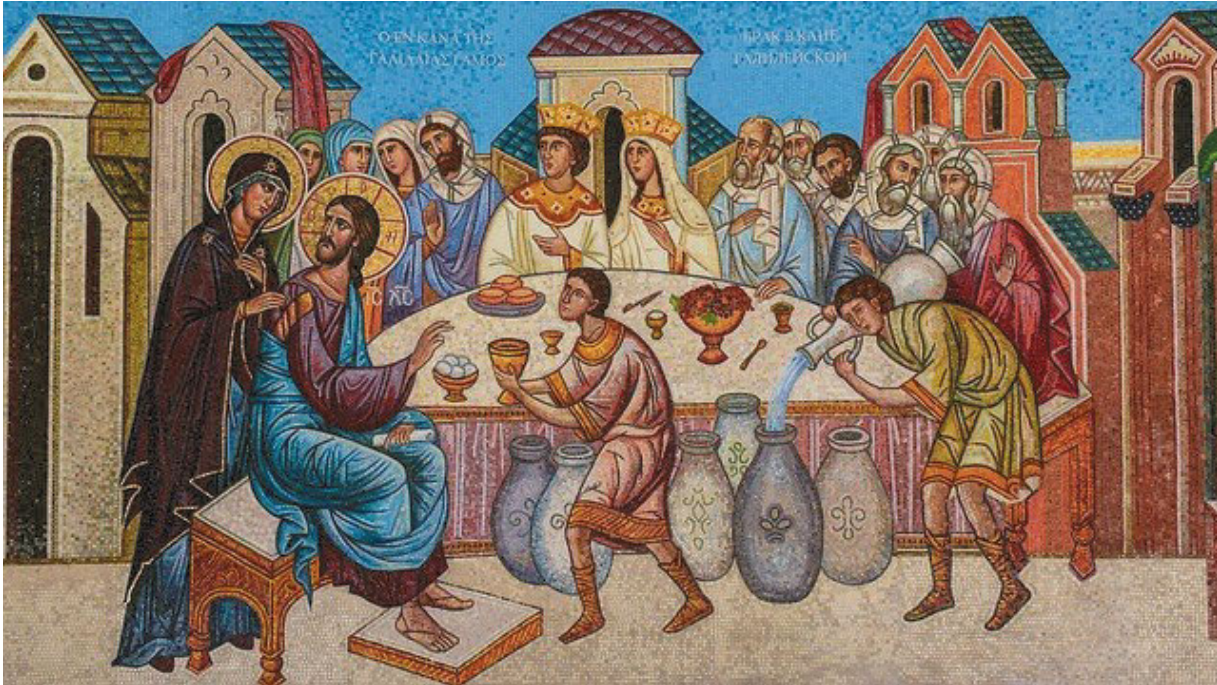

Associate Pastor's Corner—Fr. Isaiah M. Molano, OP

As we begin this new liturgical season, this new season of Ordinary Time, we come to the first miracle that Jesus had ever performed, the transformation of water into wine at the wedding in Cana. In both the Old and New Testaments, wine is a symbol of joy—the reason is obvious. Jesus had in front of him 6 stone jars that would carry 20-30 gallons of water apiece. This means that Jesus turned 180 gallons of water into wine. Moreover, in Jesus' time, when a couple gets married, it isn't some quaint affair at Pismo Beach—the entire village is invited. The next question, then, is how many people attended the wedding reception? The average village in the Holy Land at the time held approximately 200 people, men, women, and children. Now, let's do the math. Jesus just gave over 3.4 liters of the best wine to every single man, woman and child at one wedding. This is nearly one entire gallon of wine (rounding up).

Wine is a symbol of Joy, and Jesus gave this wedding reception and that's an obscene amount of it. The message is obvious—the Sacrament of Marriage is to be a Sacrament of overwhelming Joy, of overwhelming happiness and laughter, a Sacrament that that brings about flourishing, peace, and life. We pray, in a special way, for those couples who are celebrating an anniversary this year. We also pray for those couple who are struggling, that the Holy Spirit may guide you towards a renewal of your life together. We pray for those newly married, may they live their vocation well. I ask for your prayers for those couples whom I and the other priests are preparing for their wedding day—that the Holy Spirit may cement them in Christlike-Charity.

Let us pray:

Almighty and eternal God,

*You blessed the union of married couples
so that they might reflect the union of Christ
with his Church:*

look with kindness on them.

Renew their marriage covenant,

increase your love in them,

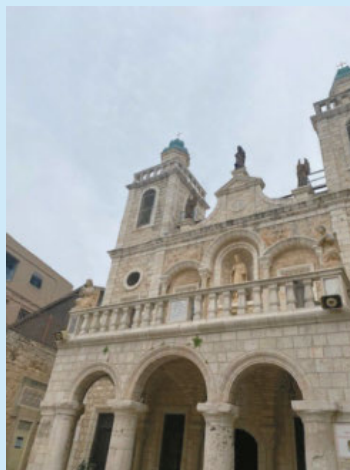
and strengthen their bond of peace

so that, with their children,

*they may always rejoice in the gift of
your blessing.*

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Rincón del Pastor Asociado—Por el Padre Isaiah M. Molano, OP

Al comenzar este nuevo tiempo litúrgico, este nuevo tiempo del Tiempo Ordinario, llegamos al primer milagro que Jesús había realizado, la transformación del agua en vino en las bodas de Caná.

Tanto en el Antiguo como en el Nuevo Testamento, el vino es un símbolo de alegría, la razón es obvia. Jesús tenía frente a él 6 tinajas de piedra que llevarían de 20 a 30 galones de agua cada una. Esto significa que Jesús convirtió 180 galones de agua en vino. Además, en la época de Jesús, cuando una pareja se casa, no se trata de un asunto pintoresco en la playa de Pismo, sino que todo el pueblo está invitado. La siguiente pregunta, entonces, es ¿cuántas personas asistieron a la recepción de la boda? La aldea promedio de Tierra Santa en ese momento tenía aproximadamente 200 personas, hombres, mujeres y niños. Ahora, hagamos los cálculos. Jesús acaba de dar más de 3,4 litros del mejor vino a cada hombre, mujer y niño en una boda. Esto es casi un galón entero de vino (redondeando).

El vino es un símbolo de alegría, y Jesús dio esta recepción de boda y esa es una cantidad obscena. El mensaje es obvio: el Sacramento del Matrimonio debe ser un Sacramento de alegría abrumadora, de felicidad y risa abrumadoras, un Sacramento que produce florecimiento, paz y vida.

Oramos, de manera especial, por aquellas parejas que este año celebran un aniversario. También oramos por aquellas parejas que están luchando, para que el Espíritu Santo los guíe hacia una renovación de su vida juntos. Rezamos por los recién casados, que vivan bien su vocación. Les pido sus oraciones por esas parejas a las que yo y los otros sacerdotes estamos preparando para el día de su boda, para que el Espíritu Santo los cimente en la caridad cristiana.

Oremos:

*Dios todopoderoso y eterno,
has bendecido la unión de los esposos
para que reflejen la unión de Cristo con su Iglesia:
míralos con bondad. Renueva su alianza matrimonial,
aumenta tu amor en ellos y fortalece su vínculo de paz
para que, con sus hijos, siempre se regocijen
en el don de e tu bendición.
Te lo pedimos por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén.*



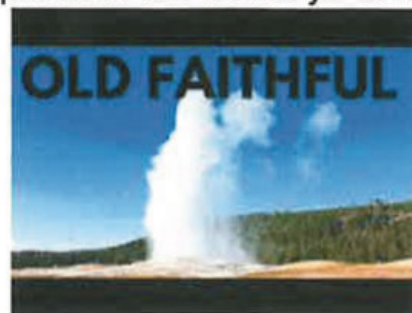
Journey to Famous National Parks
