#### **Associate Pastor's Corner**

Pope Francis has declared 2025 as a Jubilee Year for the Church. What does this mean? A jubilee year, also known as a "holy year," is a special year in the life of the Church normally celebrated every 25 years. The most recent ordinary jubilee was in 2000. Jubilee years trace their roots to the Jewish tradition of marking a jubilee year every 50 years. According to the



Vatican website for the jubilee, these years in Jewish history were "intended to be marked as a time to re-establish a proper relationship with God, with one another, and with all of creation. The theme of this Holy Year is "Pilgrims of Hope."

This Jubilee Year is titled "Hope does not disappoint," found in Romans 5:5. "Everyone knows what it is to hope," Pope Francis wrote. "In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring. "However, often we come across people who are discouraged, pessimistic and cynical about the future, as if nothing could possibly bring them happiness. But the virtue of Hope is a gift from God and for all of us, may the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope for a good things to come in our spiritual lives, for the Church, and for all the needs that we individuals hope for.

El Papa Francisco ha declarado 2025 como Año Jubilar para la Iglesia. ¿Qué significa esto? Un año jubilar, también conocido como "año santo", es un año especial en la vida de la Iglesia que normalmente se celebra cada 25 años. El último jubileo ordinario fue en el año 2000. Los años jubilares tienen sus raíces en la tradición judía de celebrar un



año jubilar cada 50 años. Según el sitio web del Vaticano para el jubileo, estos años en la historia judía estaban "destinados a ser marcados como un tiempo para restablecer una relación adecuada con Dios, entre nosotros y con toda la creación.

El tema de este Año Santo es "Peregrinos de esperanza". Este Año Jubilar se titula "La esperanza no defrauda", que se encuentra en Romanos 5:5. 
