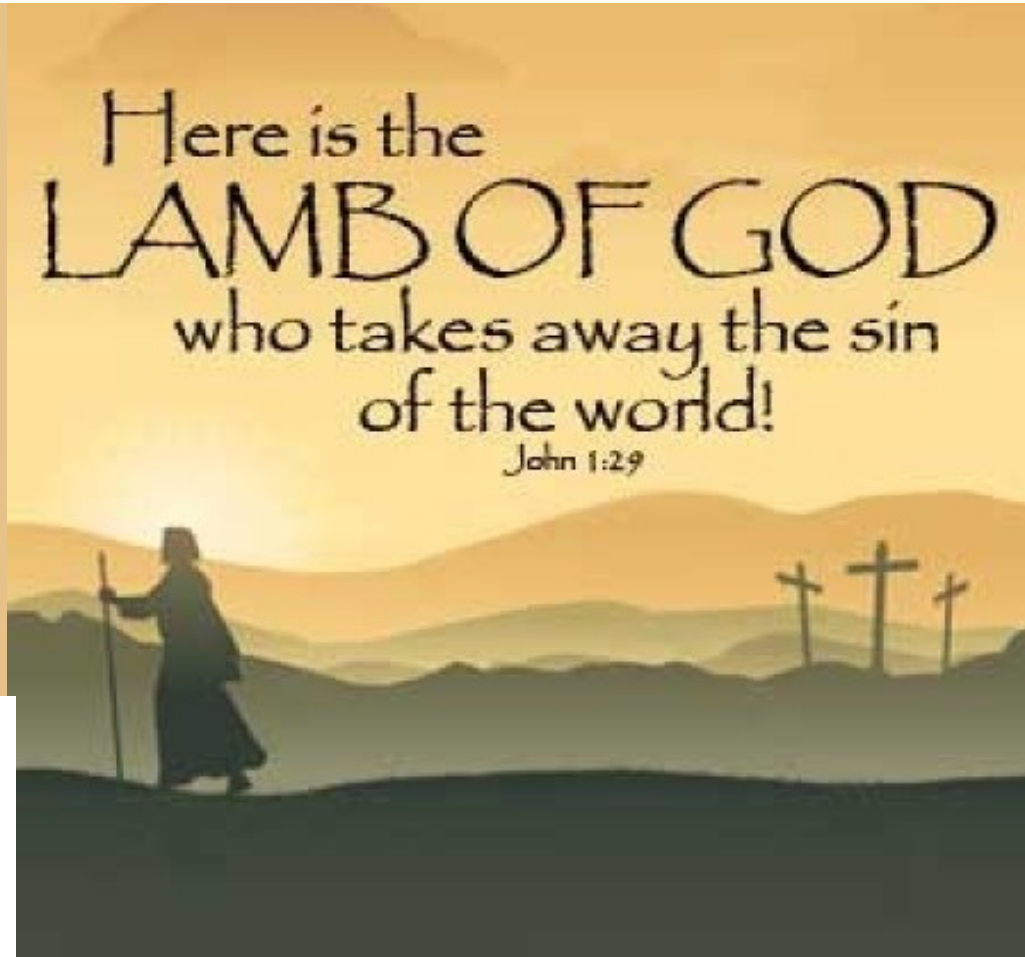

We are told that each and every single one of us has a mission in life. That each of us, with our individual talents, charisms, life experiences and personalities—we all have something to offer the human race, to the Church, and ultimately, to God. Of the many workshops, talks, experiences, I would like to offer our parish community the **Called & Gifted Workshop**.

When we were baptized, the Holy Spirit poured into a souls a set of particular gits (charisms) that help us to participate in God's life. These are your charisms, these are ways in which God is working through you so as to make the world a better place.

And to those who had taken the workshop a few years ago, I invite you take it again. I took the workshop four times before I was comfortable teaching it. To start off the new year, the Fifth Grade class is reading the story *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*. This is the story of an eleven year old girl named Sadako who lived in Japan during the time the Atomic Bomb was dropped on Hiroshima. She was directly impacted by the bomb, becoming terminally ill from radiation poisoning. As a way to become better and remain hopeful, she sets a goal of folding 1000 paper cranes believing that if she finishes she will be given a wish and become healthy again.

This story teaches students about having faith, hope, the end of life, the importance of loved ones, and promotes peace in a way that is simple and touching. As a class, we are folding 1000 paper cranes as a way to help build classroom community and to promote faith and peace. We have created 344 of the 1000 paper cranes.
