Pastor's Corner



October is "Respect Life" month for Catholics in the U.S., and we need this reminder of human dignity! Vast numbers of women have been sexually assaulted, and children are routinely

molested by adults, including priests. Bitter partisan politics lead people to treat other people like political pawns. And, of course, we must not forget the 60,760,000 abortions performed in the U.S. since Roe v. Wade in 1973. You can go to www.numberofabortions.com for a grim minute-by-minute update of national and worldwide abortions.

Part of the tragedy of abortion is there are more than 2 million couples across the U.S. right now who are waiting to adopt. For every *infant* available for adoption, 40 couples are waiting. Adoption is an option for mothers and fathers with unwanted pregnancies. Only 2-3% of more than 1 million teens who will become pregnant this year will place their child up for adoption. More than 40% will choose abortion. One baby dies every 20 seconds from abortion, while the average wait for adoption takes 2-10 *years*!

If a young, unmarried relative or friend of yours became pregnant, or impregnated a young woman, would you encourage them to consider adoption? Or would you be ashamed by their behavior and encourage them – even simply by your disapproval – to procure an abortion?

Wendy's restaurant founder Dave Thomas, TV personality Faith Daniels, and Olympic silver medalists were all adopted. Please talk about the option to abortion with your friends: ad**option**.

Presentations on Marriage

We are delighted to welcome Fr. Tom Vandenberg to our parish community as he helps us explore the Sacrament of Matrimony, focusing especially on what distinguishes it from all other marriages. He will give two presentations, on Monday and Tuesday, October 22-23 at 7 p.m. in the parish hall. Fr. Vandenberg is a priest of the Archdiocese of Seattle, ordained in 1962. In addition to parish work over these years, he was also the Archdiocesan Director of the Catholic Youth Organization and has also worked in both the Cursillo and Marriage Encounter movements. A published author, his latest book, A Pearl of Great Price; The Surprising Sacrament of Matrimony, was selected for the Seattle University Search for Meaning Book Festival in February of 2015. This book will be on sale in the parish hall after his presentations. He has been a Keynote Speaker at the National Association of Catholic Family Life Ministers in 2010, a presenter at the Mid-West Catholic Family Life Conference in 2012, and last year he gave the Keynote Address at the North American Worldwide Marriage Encounter Convention.

Father's presentations will address the following issues in a straight forward, serious, yet refreshing way:

- The difference between the Sacrament of Matrimony and a simple marriage. What difference does it make?
- The importance of Matrimony to the life of the Church
- The unique spirituality of married couples
- The relationship between the Sacrament of Matrimony and Holy Orders
- What our married couples have to say to the church, especially at this time of polarization
- Why our married couples are a sign of hope for our church

These presentations are appropriate for all married and engaged couples as well as those who are widowed or even divorced. In fact, any person interested in marriage will find the evening worthwhile, married or not. High school students are also welcome. If you come, prepare to laugh at unexpected times. The evenings are informative, inspiring and fun.
