Many of you know Fr. Donald Bramble who has lived here at St. Dominic's since 2018. Since he has been here, Fr. Donald has helped with daily Masses, preaching and confessions as well as helping out at Holy Redeemer (Montrose) and St. James the Less (La Crescenta) Parishes on the week-ends. So, some of you may know him, but others perhaps not. Because Fr. Thomas Saucier has returned to his own Dominican Province in the Midwest, we had a need for another priest **here at St. Dominic's. Fr. Donald has graciously offered to be our new associate pastor** beginning immediately.

Fr. Donald was born and raised in Los Angeles, graduating from Transfiguration School (South Central LA), Daniel Murphy High School (in the Wilshire area of Los Angeles), and Cal State LA, a true Angeleno! He was ordained in 1976 and has served in Alaska, Utah, Arizona, Northern & Southern California and Nevada. Fr.

Donald was in residence here at St. Dominic's while he served as Mission Director for our Western Dominican Province during the time Fr. Anthony Patalano was pastor here, and he is very pleased to be serving at St. Dominic's for a second time!

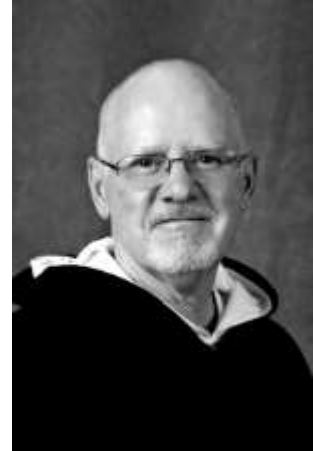
