Bus trip to the Ramona Pageant

I would like to invite all parishioners to experience the Ramona Pageant in Hemet, California. It is an outdoor play that portrays California during part of the 19th century that involves interactions between **Native Americans, Mexicans, Spaniards and Americans during a crucial time for California's history.** The pageant involves hundreds of actors and extras who represent the rich heritage of **Southern California's Native Tribes, along with Spanish dancers and musicians, horses, and cowboys.** My family has been involved with this pageant for nearly 100 years, so it is especially meaningful to me.

We will see the show scheduled for Sunday, April 26th from 3:30-6:30 p.m. We have arranged for bus transportation. **The bus will leave St. Dominic's at 11:30 a.m.** and return at approximately 8:30 p.m.

Tickets are \$80.00 per person and includes bus transportation and box seats in the shade for the Pageant. This will also include **lunch and music at Arturo's Restaurant in Hemet, before the show. Tax Credits to Keep in Mind

As you prepare your taxes this season, take special note to determine if you qualify for the California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC) or the new Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC). The CalEITC is a state tax credit for low-income working families based on a percentage of their income. Unlike most tax credits, the CalEITC is fully refundable. In its first year, it boosted the income of 385,000 families, who shared close to \$200 million. In 2019, more than two million people claimed the credit, totaling close to \$395 million. You can find out if you are eligible for both state and federal EITC benefits by visiting www.CalEITC4me.com. New this year is the Young Child Tax Credit, an additional refundable tax credit available to parents who qualify for CalEITC with at least one child younger than age six as of December 31, 2019.

Usted podría recibir hasta \$8,000 en créditos estatales y federales combinados si gana menos de \$30,000 en el 2019. Aparte, California tiene un NUEVO Crédito Tributario por Hijos Menores (YCTC) para padres con al menos un niño menor de 6 años. ¡Obtenga hasta \$1,000 adicionales!

Talk about chat room dangers with your teen. Online chat rooms are great places for people to connect over shared interests and ideas. But for young children and teenagers who may not be internet-savvy, they’re also a great place for predators to lay groundwork. In a chat room, anyone can be whomever they want — and predators hide behind personas of friends. Talk to your child about online safety rules, such as never agreeing to meet in person and never providing personal and identifying information. Review chats frequently to ensure that your child is engaging in safe conversations. Platiqué con sus hijos sobre las reglas de seguridad en línea, como por ejemplo nunca ponerse de acuerdo para conocer a alguien en persona, y nunca proveer su información personal y su información de identificación. Revise los chats frecuentemente para asegurar que su hijo/a está participando en una conversación segura.
